BORN in 1564, William Shakespeare is the most famous and important English language writer ever. His plays and sonnets are still studied in schools today.

Shakespeare's plays are known for their complex characters, complicated plots, and poetic language. Famous plays he wrote include *Romeo and Juliet*, *Hamlet* and *Macbeth*. They were performed at the Globe Theatre in London, a theatre he co-owned. It is still a popular attraction today.

He also invented hundreds of words to express his thoughts, such as 'lonely' and 'unreal'. Lines from his plays are still quoted today such as 'The course of true love never did run smooth' from *A Midsummer's Night Dream*.

The Mouse heard his roar and ran over to the Lion. He gnawed the ropes with his teeth and set the Lion free.


